1 —

VILLA TREVILLE

Positano, Italy

Off the beaten path and dripping in Old World romance, this luxury resort looks as if it's carved into the side of a cliff. "Hop a private speedboat from Sorrento Port to a quiet cove for a lunch of chilled rosé and stuffed zucchini flowers at La Conca del Sogno," Marchant recommends.

GRAND HOTEL TREMEZZO

Lake Como, Italy

With the serene waters of Lake Como setting the scene and suites that come with private butlers, this historic Art Nouveau palace hotel is next-level romantic. Marchant suggests renting an Alfa Romeo Duetto Spider to zip around the winding mountain roads and look for secluded champagne picnic spots.



3 —

CASTELLO DI RESCHIO

Umbria, Italy

Count Antonio Bolza and his son spent decades restoring part of this 2,700-acre estate to its former glory. (The main castle and about 50 farmhouses date back four centuries or more.) The infinity pool overlooks quince trees and lavender beds, and the estate's vineyard produces wines that you can sample at the property's restaurant, Osteria.



4 —

KASBAH TAMADOT

Marrakesh, Morocco

At the foothills of the Atlas Mountains, Sir Richard Branson's Kasbah Tamadot is otherworldly. (*Tamadot* is Berber for "soft breeze.") The 28 jewel-toned guest rooms are decorated with antiques from the collection of dealer Luciano Tempo. Marchant suggests a 4x4 excursion to see the intricate weaving at one of the nearby Berber villages.



5 —

IMANTA RESORTS

Punta de Mita, Mexico

The softest sand meets 250 acres of dense tropical rain forest at this remote retreat near Puerto Vallarta. "Tap into the deep spiritual roots of this part of the country by trying out a Temazcal ritual, a powerful healing ceremony that uses hot steam and aromatic potions to detoxify," says Marchant.



6 —

CAP ROCAT

Mallorca, Spain

Cap Rocat exists in a universe all its own—you have to cross a drawbridge just to get to this revamped Bay of Palma fortress. There are 21 multilevel Mediterranean-view suites outfitted with every creature comfort, and the dramatic architecture shines. A massive infinity pool overlooks Mallorca's finest stretch of sand and sea.
